



# Architects & Engineers Program General Liability

#### Causes of Loss:

- Slip/trip/fall
- Struck by/contact with
- Fall from different levels-ladder's, scaffolds, ramps
- Business Torts
- Construction Defect

## **GL Large Loss Causes:**

- Two primary loss causes:
  - Construction/Site Related accidents
  - Hired/Non-Owned Auto Accidents (GL endorsement)



# Architects & Engineers Program General Liability

### **Professional Liability Claims & General Liability Exposures:**

 National Program Claim reviews every declination, reservation of rights and other coverage letters for consistency on professional services exclusion.

### There are cases where the pleading may trigger a duty to defend:

- These include failure to warn
- Allegations of safety responsibility
- Additional Insured issues
- Alleged job site activities beyond inspection or professional design.
- The complaint does not distinguish which allegations are against the GC vs.
  the insured


